## THE ANGEL GABRIEL VISITS MARY AND SHARES THE GOOD NEWS

### [Luke 1:26-38 \(KJV\)](#)

(26) And in the sixth month the angel Gabriel was sent from God unto a city of Galilee, named Nazareth, (27) To a virgin espoused to a man whose name was Joseph, of the house of David; and the virgin's name was Mary. (28) And the angel came in unto her, and said, Hail, thou that art highly favoured, the Lord is with thee: blessed art thou among women. (29) And when she saw him, she was troubled at his saying, and cast in her mind what manner of salutation this should be. (30) And the angel said unto her, Fear not, Mary: for thou hast found favour with God. (31) And, behold, thou shalt conceive in thy womb, and bring forth a son, and shalt call his name JESUS. (32) He shall be great, and shall be called the Son of the Highest: and the Lord God shall give unto him the throne of his father David: (33) And he shall reign over the house of Jacob for ever; and of his kingdom there shall be no end. (34) Then said Mary unto the Angel, How shall this be, I know not a man? (35) And the angel answered and said unto her, The Holy Ghost shall come upon thee, and the power of the Highest shall overshadow thee: therefore also that holy thing which shall be born of thee shall be called the Son of God.

(26) Now in the sixth month the angel Gabriel was sent from God to a town in Galilee, named Nazareth, (27) To a virgin who was to be married to a man named Joseph, of the family of David; and the name of the virgin was Mary. (28) And the angel came in to her and said, Peace be with you, to whom special grace has been given; the Lord is with you. (29) But she was greatly troubled at his words, and said to herself, What may be the purpose of these words? (30) And the angel said to her, Have no fear, Mary, for you have God's approval. (31) And see, you will give birth to a son, and his name will be Jesus. (32) He will be great, and will be named the Son of the Most High: and the Lord God will give him the kingdom of David, his father: (33) He will have rule over the house of Jacob for ever, and of his kingdom there will be no end. (34) And Mary said to the angel, How may this be, because I have had no knowledge of a man? (35) And the angel in answer said to her, The Holy Spirit will come on you, and the power of the Most High will come to rest on you, and so that which will come to birth will be named holy, Son of God.

## JOSEPH LEARNS OF THE SOON COMING KING



[Matthew 1:18-21,24 \(KJV\)](#)

(18) Now the birth of Jesus Christ was on this wise: When as his mother Mary was espoused to Joseph, before they came together, she was found with child of the Holy Ghost. (19) Then Joseph her husband, being a just man, and not willing to make her a publick example, was minded to put her away privily. (20) But while he thought on these things, behold, the angel of the Lord appeared unto him in a dream, saying, Joseph, thou son of David, fear not to take unto thee Mary thy wife: for that which is conceived in her is of the Holy Ghost. (21) And she shall bring forth a son, and thou shalt call his name JESUS: for he shall save his people from their sins. (24) Then Joseph being raised from sleep did as the angel of the Lord had bidden him, and took unto him his wife:

(18) Now the birth of Jesus Christ was in this way: when his mother Mary was going to be married to Joseph, before they came together the discovery was made that she was with child by the Holy Spirit. (19)

And Joseph, her husband, being an upright man, and not desiring to make her a public example, had a mind to put her away privately. (20) But when he was giving thought to these things, an angel of the Lord came to him in a dream, saying, Joseph, son of David, have no fear of taking Mary as your wife; because that which is in her body is of the Holy Spirit. (21) And she will give birth to a son; and you will give him the name Jesus; for he will give his people salvation from their sins. (24) And Joseph did as the angel of the Lord had said to him, and took her as his wife;

(18) El nacimiento de Jesucristo fue así: Estando desposada María su madre con José, antes que se juntasen, se halló que había concebido del Espíritu Santo. ### MARY AND JOSEPH TRAVEL TO BETHLEHEM

#### [Luke 2:1-5 \(KJV\)](#)

(1) And it came to pass in those days, that there went out a decree from Caesar Augustus, that all the world should be taxed. (2) (And this taxing was first made when Cyrenius was governor of Syria.) (3) And all went to be taxed, every one into his own city. (4) And Joseph also went up from Galilee, out of the city of Nazareth, into Judaea, unto the city of David, which is called Bethlehem; (because he was of the house and lineage of David:;) (5) To be taxed with Mary his espoused wife, being great with child.

#### [Luke 2:1-5 \(BBE\)](#)

(1) Now it came about in those days that an order went out from Caesar Augustus that there was to be a numbering of all the world. (2) This was the first numbering, which was made when Quirinius was ruler of Syria. (3) And all men went to be numbered, everyone to his town. (4) And Joseph went up from Galilee, out of the town of Nazareth, into Judaea, to Bethlehem, the town of David, because he was of the house and family of David, (5) To be put on the list with Mary, his future wife, who was about to become a mother.

[Luke 2:6-7 \(BBE\)](#)

(6) And while they were there, the time came for her to give birth. (7) And she had her first son; and folding him in linen, she put him to rest in the place where the cattle had their food, because there was no room for them in the house.

[Luke 2:6-7 \(RV1960\)](#)

(6) Y aconteció que estando ellos allí, se cumplieron los días de su alumbramiento. (7) Y dio a luz a su hijo primogénito, y lo envolvió en pañales, y lo acostó en un pesebre, porque no había lugar para ellos en el mesón.

(25) And knew her not till she had brought forth her firstborn son: and he called his name JESUS.

(25) And he had no connection with her till she had given birth to a son; and he gave him the name Jesus.

### [Luke 2:8-14 \(KJV\)](#)

(8) And there were in the same country shepherds abiding in the field, keeping watch over their flock by night. (9) And, lo, the angel of the Lord came upon them, and the glory of the Lord shone round about them: and they were sore afraid. (10) And the angel said unto them, Fear not: for, behold, I bring you good tidings of great joy, which shall be to all people. (11) For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Saviour, which is Christ the Lord. (12) And this shall be a sign unto you; Ye shall find the babe wrapped in swaddling clothes, lying in a manger. (13) And suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host praising God, and saying, (14) Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace, good will toward men.

### [Luke 2:8-14 \(BBE\)](#)

(8) And in the same country there were keepers of sheep in the fields, watching over their flock by night. (9) And an angel of the Lord came to them, and the glory of the Lord was shining round about them: and fear came on them. (10) And the angel said, Have no fear; for truly, I give you good news of great joy which will be for all the people: (11) For on this day, in the town of David, a Saviour has come to birth, who is Christ the Lord. (12) And this is the sign to you: you will see a young child folded in linen, in the place where the cattle have their food. (13) And suddenly there was with the angel a great band of spirits from heaven, giving praise to God, and saying, (14) Glory to God in the highest, and on the earth peace among men with whom he is well pleased.

### [Luke 2:8-14 \(RV1960\)](#)

(8) Había pastores en la misma región, que velaban y guardaban las viglias de la noche sobre su rebaño. (9) Y he aquí, se les presentó un ángel del Señor, y la gloria del Señor los rodeó de resplandor; y tuvieron gran temor. ## SHEPHERDS COME, WORSHIP JESUS, AND SHARE THE GOOD NEWS



### [Luke 2:15-20 \(KJV\)](#)

(15) And it came to pass, as the angels were gone away from them into heaven, the shepherds said one to another, Let us now go even unto Bethlehem, and see this thing which is come to pass, which the Lord hath made known unto us. (16) And they came with haste, and found Mary, and Joseph, and the babe lying in a manger. (17) And when they had seen it, they made known abroad the saying which was told them concerning this child. (18) And all they that heard it wondered at those things which were told them by the shepherds. (19) But Mary kept all these things, and pondered them in her heart. (20) And the shepherds returned, glorifying and praising God for all the things that they had heard and seen, as it was told unto them.

### [Luke 2:15-20 \(BBE\)](#)

(15) And when the angels had gone away from them into heaven, the keepers of the sheep said to one another, Let us go now to Bethlehem, and see this thing which has come about, which the Lord has made clear to us. (16) And they came quickly, and saw Mary and Joseph, and the

child in the place where the cattle had their food. (17) And when they saw it, they gave them an account of the things which had been said to them about the child. (18) And all those to whose ears it came were full of wonder at the things said by the keepers of the sheep. (19) But Mary kept all these words in her heart, and gave much thought to them. (20) Then the keepers of the sheep went back, giving glory and praise to God for all the things which had come to their ears and which they had seen, as it had been said to them.

## THE WISE MEN SEEK TO WORSHIP JESUS AND GIVE HIM GIFTS

[Matthew 2:1-2, 9-12 \(KJV\)](#)

(1) Now when Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judaea in the days of Herod the king, behold, there came wise men from the east to Jerusalem, (2) Saying, Where is he that is born King of the Jews? for we have seen his star in the east, and are come to worship him. (9) When they had heard the king, they departed; and, lo, the star, which they saw in the east, went before them, till it came and stood over where the young child was. (10) When they saw the star, they rejoiced with exceeding great joy. (11) And when they were come into the house, they saw the young child with Mary his mother, and fell down, and worshipped him: and when they had opened their treasures, they presented unto him gifts; gold, and frankincense, and myrrh.

[Matthew 2:1-2, 9-12 \(BBE\)](#)

(1) Now when the birth of Jesus took place in Bethlehem of Judaea, in the days of Herod the king, there came wise men from the east to Jerusalem, (2) Saying, Where is the King of the Jews whose birth has now taken place? We have seen his star in the east and have come to

give him worship. (9) And after hearing the king, they went on their way; and the star which they saw in the east went before them, till it came to rest over the place where the young child was. (10) And when they saw the star they were full of joy. (11) And they came into the house, and saw the young child with Mary, his mother; and falling down on their faces they gave him worship; and from their store they gave him offerings of gold, perfume, and spices. (12) And it was made clear to them by God in a dream that they were not to go back to Herod; so they went into their country by another way.

## THE REAL REASON FOR THE CHRISTMAS STORY: THE WORD MADE FLESH



[John 1:1-5,9-14 \(KJV\)](#)

(1) **In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.** (2) The same was in the beginning with God. (3) All things were made by him; and without him was not any thing made that was made. (4) In him was life; and the life was the light of men. (5) And the light shineth in darkness; and the darkness comprehended it not. (9) That was the true Light, which lighteth every man that cometh into the world. (10) He was in the world, and the world was made by him, and the world knew him not. (11) He came unto his own, and his own received him not. (12) But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name: (13) Which were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God. (14) **And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth.**

[John 1:1-5, 9-14 \(BBE\)](#)

(1) **From the first he was the Word, and the Word was in relation with God and was God.** (2) This Word was from the first in relation with God. (3) All things came into existence through him, and without him nothing was. (4) What came into existence in him was life, and the life was the light of men. (5) And the light goes on shining in the dark; it is not overcome by the dark. (9) The true light, which gives light to every man, was then coming into the world. (10) He was in the world, the world which came into being through him, but the world had no knowledge of him. (11) He came to the things which were his and his people did not take him to their hearts. (12) To all those who did so take him, however, he gave the right of becoming children of God--that is, to those who had faith in his name: (13) Whose birth was from God and not from blood, or from an impulse of the flesh and man's desire. (14) **And so the Word became flesh and took a place among us for a time; and we saw his glory--such glory as is given to an only son by his father--saw it to be true and full of grace.**

[John 1:1-5,9-14 \(RV1960\)](#)

(1) **En el principio era el Verbo, y el Verbo era con Dios, y el Verbo era Dios.** (2) Este era en el principio con Dios. (3) Todas las cosas por él fueron hechas, y sin él nada de lo que ha sido hecho, fue hecho. (4) En él estaba la vida, y la vida era la luz de los hombres. ## JESUS DECLARES THE GOSPEL

[Mark 1:14-15 \(KJV\)](#)

(14) Now after that John was put in prison, Jesus came into Galilee, preaching the gospel of the kingdom of God, (15) And saying, **The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand: repent ye, and believe the gospel.**

[Mark 1:14-15 \(AMP\)](#)

(14) Now after John [the Baptist] was arrested and taken into custody, Jesus went to Galilee, preaching the good news of [the kingdom of] God, (15) and saying, **“The [appointed period of] time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand; repent [change your inner self—your old way of thinking, regret past sins, live your life in a way that proves repentance; seek God’s purpose for your life] and believe [with a deep, abiding trust] in the good news [regarding salvation].”**
